OZARK ADVENTIST ACADEMY MATCHING SCHOLARSHIP PLAN FOR THE ARKANSAS-LOUISIANA CONFERENCE*

Students who are not able to attend Ozark Adventist Academy because of an inability to finance the cost may be eligible for beneficiaries of the Ozark Adventist Academy Matching Scholarship Plan in the amount of up to \$2,250.00 as follows.

- I. Eligibility for Academy Matching Scholarship as follows:
 - A. Local church participation.
 - B. Student participation in a full academy curriculum.
 - C. Student citizenship must be satisfactory.
 - D. Student cooperation in the work program with a minimum of 15 hours per week. Students will be expected to make themselves available for industry employment.
 - E. Student is eligible to receive only one scholarship per year. (Students receiving other scholarship monies from a Conference or subsidy would not be eligible).

- II. The procedure is as follows:
 - A. Local churches of which the student or his parents or guardian are members must make a preliminary determination of financial need and nominate the student for a scholarship of up to \$2,250.00. This action is to be done via the church board.
 - ** B. The treasurer of the local church will send the completed application form and the church's share of this scholarship, up to \$750.00 (\$500 for a day student), to Ozark Adventist Academy on or before July 31. (Applications are available from the academy administration.)
 - C. The academy will match up to \$750.00, the Arkansas-Louisiana Conference up to \$750.00, thus making a scholarship of up to \$2,250.00, based upon the amount the church contributes. These funds will be held in trust by the academy. A day student total would be \$1500.00.
 - D. The scholarship shall be released to the student's account at the rate of one-eighth per billing. In cases where a student does not complete the school year, any unused portion of the scholarship remaining after the month in which the student leaves would be proportionately returned to the original sources.

*Those who are from a conference other than Arkansas-Louisiana need to check with their local conference to see if they will match for the conference portion. The school will match for the school portion but cannot give the conference portion if the conference does not participate.

Money contributed to the church for the Academy Scholarship Plan **cannot be designated for use of any particular applicant, but it is equally available to any and all applicants as determined by the local church board. Parents or guardians are expected to pay their money directly to the student's account except as they would donate funds for any recipient.
