

Trip Expectations

1. Come Prepared

What to Bring:

One Suitcase Per Student (you have to lug it around ☺)
Sleeping Bag or Sheets & Blanket
Pillow
Towels & washcloths (for the nights in dorms)
Toothbrush & other toiletries
Flip flops for showers (dorms)
Sufficient clothes for the trip – School Dress Code Applies
Jacket and/or Sweatshirt
Gloves & Hat (if you know you're a lightweight ☺)
Comfortable shoes (we'll be doing lots of walking)
Laundry Detergent (you will have access to a laundry if needed)
Umbrella or rain poncho (just in case)
Small backpack (security has limitations on size)
Camera (extra storage card if needed)
Something to tell time with (i.e. watch or phone)
Money for snacks & souvenirs
Guitars for Worship
A flexible, positive attitude ☺

2. Choose to be an asset to the Group

Be on Time:

When given a time to be somewhere (i.e. worship, breakfast, room, or meeting place) be on time.

If you are late:

1 st Offense:	9% grade deduction off of presentation
2 nd Offense:	11% grade deduction off of presentation
Excessively Late:	subject to removal from trip at your parents expense.

Be where Asked:

When asked to stay or be somewhere specific, stay or be there. Let your group leader know if you need to leave the group for any reason.

When given a curfew, be in your own room at that time and stay there. There will not be any reason to leave your room, all of the sponsors have cell phones if you need something. Do not ask a sponsor to take you somewhere after curfew; they want a good night's sleep too.

Under no circumstance should a guy/girl be found in the room of the opposite sex, or even in the hallway. Guys and girls will be on different floors, there should not be any reason to see you on the wrong floor/hall. If you choose to ignore this rule you will be sent home immediately at your parents expense and be sent to ad council for further discipline. This can adversely affect your status in any organization you are a member of.

Be Social:

Get out of your comfort zone and make new friends.

Couples: OAA social rules apply. If you choose to not follow them you will be sent home at your parents expense and be sent to ad council for further discipline.

Comply with the following rules:
